You will need to bring everything normally needed for painting outside (easel, brushes, paints, mineral spirits, paper towels, warm clothing, comfortable shoes, a bag or cart to corral everything, etc.) adding the items listed below.

- 1) Your normal color palette, adding:
Warm, rich dark such as Van Dyke Brown
Medium of your choice; I like Gamblin's Solvent Free Gel
- 2) Non-textured panel of your choice, in a comfortable dimension for you. I like Gessobord Museum Series Panels by Ampersand
- 3) Lighting: needs to attach to your easel and be balanced light (not too warm or cool). I use a clip on light by Ottlite (LED Magnifier Lamp with clip) which I sell on my website's Workshops page.

- 4) Hat with brim
- 5) Sketchbook
- 6) Graphite pencil and eraser
- 7) Viewfinder (nothing fancy; I use one cut from mat board specific to my panel dimensions)
- 8) Flashlight!
