ARTIST AGREEMENT FORM & PROSPECTUS

THEME: an exhibit of artwork that showcases the brilliant color, pattern, and texture of birds

ART SPECIFICATIONS:

- Works must focus on birds as the main subject
- 18x24 size limit for exhibited work
- If you have larger artwork you may submit it, but only a small quantity of those works will be chosen.
- Work must be ready to hang with a WIRE HANGER ONLY (no dogtooth or other styles).

EXHIBIT TERMS:

- No fee to submit. \$20 hang fee per accepted piece (10 fees waived per year for artist level members).
- Work must be dropped off with a SIGNED prospectus (this document).
- Wallkill River School will take a 30% commission on all art sales.
- The artist can pick up a check for 70% of the sale price within 30 days of show closing.

JURYING:

- Max of 4 submissions per artist.
- Submit via email to info@wallkill.art with the exhibit name in the subject line.
- Include your name and phone number in the email body.
- Each submitted work must include: JPEG image, Title, Medium, Size (in inches).
- If you need help, WRS staff will help you photograph/submit on Tuesdays from 10am-1pm.
- Results will be announced within one week following the submission deadline.

DATES:

- **August 14th Deadline** To submit work for Jurying
- **August 31st Deadline** To Drop-Off art work at Wallkill River School
- **September 7th** Reception 5-7pm (feel free to bring wine or finger food)
- **September 29th** Exhibit end date
